**Children's Sunday School (Preschool through 5<sup>th</sup> grade)**

This February, Sunday School is going to the dogs! Through "In the Dog House," our curriculum on tackling Sibling Rivalry, we will look at ways God wants brothers and sisters to control anger, be honest, encourage each other and forgive each other. Children's Sunday School is for preschoolers (3-year-olds who are eligible for public/private preschool) through 5<sup>th</sup> graders. All students meet at 11 a.m. in Room 9 in the Kitchen Wing (Kids' Church Room) for large group worship songs, skits and videos. At 11:30 a.m., the children are dismissed for age-based small group classes. Age-based classes are:

**Youth Class (Grades 6 to 12<sup>th</sup>):**

Come and join us on Sunday at 11am in the Youth Wing for discussion and Bible study around topics pertaining to youth today. Each week is different with music, discussion, sometimes food, and different experiences. New students welcome each week. Led by Pete Fitzroy.

**Adult Classes:**

**\*Christianity 201: Knowing More About What You Believe (Led by Ron Stimers)**

Come join us as we continue studying and discussing our beliefs as Christians. Topics this semester include what we believe about the Cross, the Holy Spirit, Prayer, Spiritual Warfare, Victory over Sin, the Sovereignty of God, etc. This class will also specifically address questions of those who grew up in the Roman Catholic church. **\*Survey of the Minor Prophets: (Led by Jon Ketcham)**

Have you ever studied the Old Testament Prophets? For many, this is the most underread part of your Bible – but one that is chock full of important truths for us today. Join us as we work through a prophet a week – starting with Hosea and going all the way to Malachi, studying the theme of God's overarching love in the midst of our faithlessness. **Meets in Room 7 in the Kitchen Wing.**

**\*Great Hymns (Led by Deb Potter)**

Do you love the great hymns of the Christian faith? Come and join us as we study some of the most loved and best known hymns. Each week we will focus on a particular hymn – how it came to be written, the Scripture truths in the hymn, and the music itself. **Meets in the Choir Room in the Youth Wing.**

**\*Young Marrieds (Led by Nick and Julia D'Onofrio)**

This is a new class geared towards the needs of young couples who are in their first 10 years of marriage, with or without kids. Join others here at Hope in their 20's and 30's as we explore "The Five Love Languages" by Gary Chapman. **Meets in the Conference Room in the Office Wing.**
